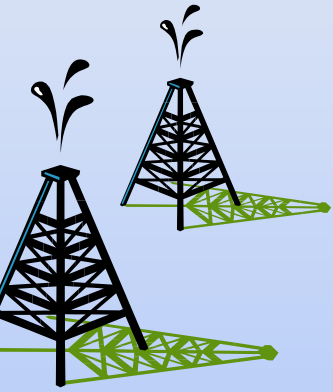

Morris Burns

Morris graduated from the University of Texas. From 1979 to 1986, he was the President of FerreTronics, Inc., a manufacturer and distributor of oil field gas detectors in Abilene, TX. He was responsible for securing U.S. Patent for their gas detectors. Then, from 1986 to 1998 he served as the Executive Vice President of the West Central Texas Oil & Gas Association in Abilene, TX. Beginning in 1997, he was the President of the Permian Basin Petroleum Association.

In 2006, he retired from full time association business, and opened a public relations and safety consulting firm doing safety classes and public relations for many firms both in and out of the petroleum industry.

He is a frequent contributor to local TV news concerning the oil and gas industry in the Permian Basin. He has also been on the weekly radio show since 1998 on KWEL 1070 AM and 107.1 FM from 8:00 am to 9:00 am on Tuesdays talking about oil and gas issues.

He recently took the Land and Leasing course at Midland College and has become active as a petroleum landman.

His professional associations include Interstate Oil & Gas Compact Commissions, Board of Directors Permian Basin International Oil Show, Midland Chamber of Commerce Legislative Committee, Director of the Midland Rotary Club, and docent of the Permian Basin Petroleum Museum.

His hobbies include fly fishing, hunting, and playing harmonica. He is married to Connie who is an accountant with Halliburton. They have one daughter, Lauren Reeves, who is a Physician Assistant in Frisco, Texas.

He will be presenting a program on the recent history of crude oil prices and the related ups and downs of the oil industry.

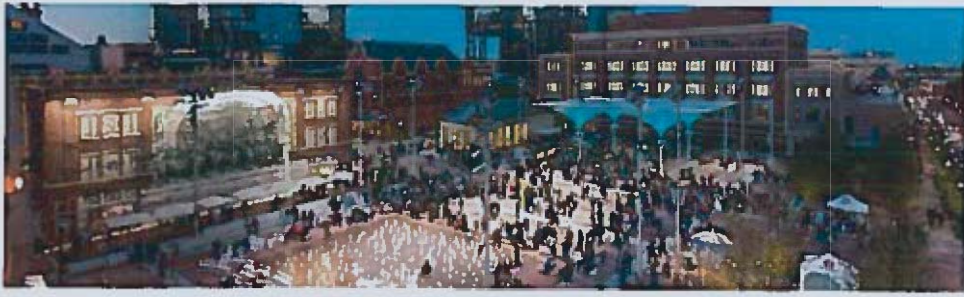
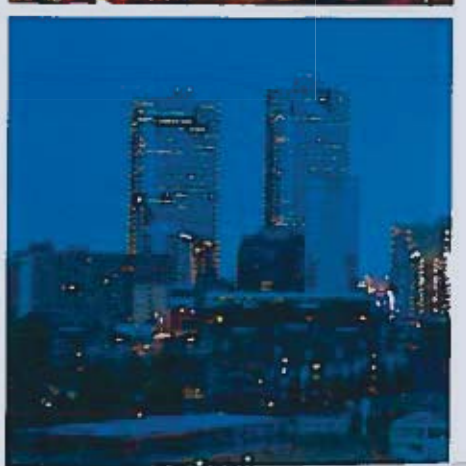
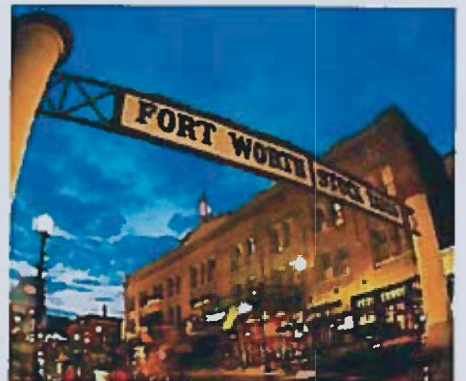
