## Oil & Gas Reserve Reports

**William M. Kazmann**, President and Senior Partner of LaRoche Petroleum Consultants, Ltd. ("LPC"), Richardson, Texas, received his Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in Petroleum Engineering from the University of Texas at Austin in 1973 and 1975, respectively. He has worked in the oil and gas industry since that time and has performed a variety of engineering duties ranging from supervising and planning drilling, completion, and production operations to estimating oil and gas reserves and providing expert testimony to various state regulatory bodies.

From 1974 to 1980, Mr. Kazmann worked for three small independent companies in Midland, Oklahoma City, and Dallas (TX). He prepared reserve evaluations for potential drilling prospects, evaluated new wells for banking purposes, performed petrophysical analyses, supervised drilling, completion and production operations, supervised geologic operations, and provided technical testimony at various state regulatory hearings.

From 1980 to 1996, Mr. Kazmann was a principal in three independent oil and gas companies which he founded or co-founded. These companies developed oil and gas prospects for sale to industry partners, acquired and sold oil and gas properties, and performed engineering consulting services.

Mr. Kazmann joined LPC in 1996 and currently serves the firm as President. He continues to perform a variety of engineering functions for both domestic and international clients.

Mr. Kazmann is a Licensed Professional Engineer in the State of Texas and is a member of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists, Society of Petroleum Engineers, Society of Independent Professional Earth Scientists (serving as National Director from 1993 to 1996 and National Treasurer in 1994 and 1995), Dallas Geological Society, and Dallas Petroleum Club (serving as Director from 2004 through 2006).

## Joint Interest and Audit Committees

MFI-38 Materials Manual will be voted on at the Spring Meeting. If MFI-38 is approved, there are 18 MFIs and 1 AG that will be considered for retirement. Appendix H in MFI-38 describes how each of the affected publications were incorporated into MFI-38 or why they are no longer relevant publications. A vote to retire MFI-6, MFI-7, MFI-8, MFI-9, MFI-10, MFI-11, MFI-12, MFI-13, MFI-15, MFI-16, MFI-20, MFI-22, MFI-24, MFI-25, MFI-28, MFI-32, MFI-33, MFI-34, and AG-5 is contingent upon passage of the Materials Manual document. The MFIs will require a 2/3 vote to approve the retirement and AG-5 will require a majority vote to approve retirement.

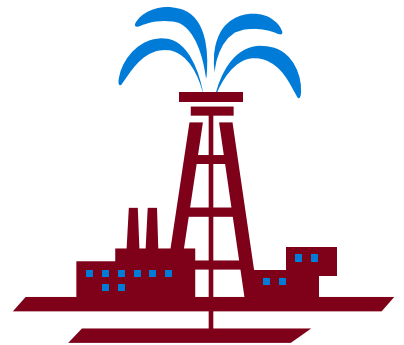
# PASPB Board of Directors Meetings
